ARTICLE 23 – BARGAINING UNIT MEMBER TRAVEL

- 23.1 The Board shall reimburse Bargaining Unit Members for travel between schools at the prevailing mileage rate, or an equivalent per diem, for Bargaining Unit Members who are daily assigned by the District to two (2) or more schools. Forms for reimbursement shall be submitted to the Bargaining Unit Member's immediate supervisor.
 - 23.1 <u>Fort Irwin Mileage Stipend</u>: Any Bargaining Unit Member who is assigned to Ft. Irwin as a regular work site and who cannot live on Post or any Bargaining Unit Member living on Ft. Irwin assigned to a valley school as their work site shall receive a monthly stipend of \$200 per month, payable each month, for a total of \$2000.

5 days	100%
4 days	80%
3 days	60%
2 days	40%
1 day	20%

A Bargaining Unit Member teaching summer school who meets the above criteria will receive the \$200 stipend. Anyone that rides the district provided bus does not qualify for this stipend.

- 23.2 Mileage from a Bargaining Unit Member's residence to the Bargaining Unit Member's work site assignment will not be reimbursed except as otherwise noted in 23.1 and Appendix B for Fort Irwin stipend.
- 23.3 Bargaining Unit Members shall receive the prevailing mileage rate when using a personal vehicle for the conducting of official school business, providing the Bargaining Unit Member receives prior authorization from the Superintendent or designee and no District vehicle is available.
